Fall 2014: Police murder of Mike Brown, Akai Gurley, Eric Garner, and countless black and brown people sparks a rebellion beginning in Ferguson and spreading to cities across the country and the world. Police respond with violence and continue to blame the victims while they get away with murder every day.
